Progress

- Coeur d'Alene became the first and only city in Idaho requiring all licensed child care centers to follow Safe Sleep Guidelines.
- Received grants from United Way of North Idaho and CDA Kiwanis to expand our "Safe Sleep Survival Kits for Idaho Babies" crib program to Idaho's 5 northern counties.
- Partnered with Southwest Idaho District Health, Amherst Madison Legacy Nagle Group and Idaho Central Credit Union to provide cribs and monthly safe sleep class in Canyon County.
